- Make nature crafts for young kids.

Join the N.H. Tree Farm Program as Bruce Townsend and his daughter Heidi Bundy share their property with us and talk about how their family has cared for this property for over 200 years.

With a goal of "leaving the land better than we found it," each generation of the family has worked to make improvements to the property and find new niches to enhance the productivity of the operation.

The family is managing and planning for the expansion of their 1,500 tap sugar bush. They produce a variety of maple products and tend a nut orchard that was planted by Bruce's great grandfather over 100 years ago. They also harvest timber, process and deliver firewood, saw lumber, turn wood bowls, and raise bees. A portion of the property is leased to the city of Lebanon for use as a ski area. A conservation easement ensures that most of the property will remain undeveloped in the future.

More than 1,450 Tree Farmers manage 500,000 acres of forestland in the Granite State. The N.H. Tree Farm Committee awards one tree farm the honor of Outstanding Tree Farm of the Year.

- 11:30 Haywagon tour through fields. Stops include county champion butternut tree and discussion about controlling invasive plants.
- 12:30 Lunch (chicken BBQ and pig roast), award presentation, raffle
- 2:00 Bruce and Heidi will show us their diverse farm activities including: processing nuts from their nut grove; beekeeping; and wood processor, sawmill, and lathe demonstrations. The barn houses a colony of bats and we will discuss bat-friendly practices.

Directions from Concord and points east:

Take Interstate 89 west toward Lebanon, NH. Take Exit 17 off I-89. Turn left onto Rte 4 (towards Lebanon). In approximately 0.5 miles, turn left onto Laplante Road. Follow Laplante Road until it ends (approximately 1 mile) and then turn right onto Meriden Road. Follow Meriden Road for approximately 0.1 miles and turn left onto Daisy Hill Road. In less than 0.1 miles, bear to the right onto Storrs Hill Road. Travel approximately one mile on Storrs Hill Road and Tomapo Farm will be on your right. Follow the signs for parking.
